- b. Unprovoked murder and assault;
- c. Prompt medical reimbursement;
- d. Accidental medical reimbursement;
- e. Daily hospital income benefit;

h. Coverage protection 24 hours a day, anywhere in the world for 365 days;

i. Same coverage for regular faculty members, admin personnel and members of the Board of Trustees:

j. Allocation of claims fund to PhilSCA to be used during emergency situations.

- 2. The contract will cover all eligible claims from all PhilSCA campuses starting from June 4, 2018 to June 4, 2019
- 3. The minimum bid is PhP 100.00 per student. All proposals must be submitted in closed envelope on or before the closing date reflected in the PhilGEPS posting/invitation.

4. The insurance is open for Contract-of-Service faculty members and admin personnel provided they will pay

the premium.

5. The insurance provider will submit all pertinent documents needed for proper auditing and accounting procedures such as but not limited to the following: BIR Registration, SEC registration, Mayor's Permit, Tax Clearance, Omnibus Sworn Statement, PhilGEPS Certification, etc.

6. The insurance provider will submit five percent, 5%, of the Contract Price as Performance Security to the

College and refundable only after all claims are settled.

7. In case the winning bidder is an insurance agent, they need to present the following:

a. Updated registration and permit to operate from Insurance Commission:

- b. Letter of Confirmation issued by the Insurer that the insurance agent is authorize to transact non-life insurance business and to collect premiums in behalf of the Insurer;
- c. Letter of Confirmation issued by the Insurer certifying that the insurance agent has submitted the actual number of enrollees from PhilSCA as reflected in the approved Insurance Policy.
