This Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated July 3, 2023 is being issued to clarify, modify or amend items in the Bidding Documents.

The following items in the Bidding Documents for the Outsourcing of Commercial Pilot License Ground and Flight Training for thirty - six (36) BSAT Students as discussed and agreed during the prebid conference held last June 27, 2023 are hereby revised/amended:

1. Section VII. Technical Specifications

4. Other Discussion

- a. The BAC secretariat read and discussed the contents of the bidding documents. Bidders are made to understand the documents they need to submit as discussed in provided checklist. Bidders are reminded to sign all pages of the duplicate copies.
- b. Bidders are reminded that engagement with the HEIs must be aviation-related training or services (such as On-the-Job Training) of students.
- c. One of the bidders requested to be clarified regarding the SLCC. They asked if they no single largest contract that has a contract price of at least 50% of the ABC, what other option they can do. The BAC answered that as stated in the bidding documents, specifically on section 5.3.c.i, the bidders are allowed to submit at least two similar contracts provided that the combined contract cost is equivalent to at least 50% of the ABC.
- d. The bidder also asked if they can present contract for SLCC that is not related to ground or flight training. The end-user, Engr. Sudweste, explained that the SLCC must be related to ground or flight training and not aircraft maintenance training. He also added the contracts for maintenance training can be considered as an engagement in HEIs.

This Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 1 shall form part of the Bid Documents. Any provision in the Bid Documents inconsistent herewith is hereby amended, modified, and superseded accordingly.
